# Frequently asked questions

# Ceremony

Which rooms are available for Ceremonies?

- The Great Hall, Gold Room, and Conservatory are all licensed for Civil Wedding/Partnership Ceremonies.
- Ceremonies must be booked between 12 PM 2 PM.

How many guests can attend a Ceremony?

- Great Hall: Up to 120 guests
- Gold Room: Up to 66 guests
- Conservatory: Up to 40 guests

What is the cost of a Ceremony?

- The fee is £1,495, which includes use of the dressing suite four hours before the ceremony with a Prosecco brunch for up to 8 guests.
- There is an additional fee payable to the Registrar.

How do we book a Registrar?

- You must book the Registrar separately through Lincolnshire Registry Office: 01522 782244.
- It is recommended to confirm availability before booking your date at Harlaxton Manor.

How long does the ceremony last?

• Approximately 30 minutes, longer if including readings.



#### Logistics

Guest & Bridal Party Arrival

- Guests: No more than 1 hour before the ceremony.
- Bridal Party: Can arrive earlier if the ceremony is at Harlaxton; confirm with the Events Team.

Can we access the Manor the day before?

• Yes, for setup (name cards, table plans, favors, etc.) between 12 PM - 4 PM, subject to availability.

Are children allowed?

- Yes, but they must be supervised.
- 4 highchairs are available.

Accommodation

- The Bridal Suite is available for the wedding night.
- Additional rooms are available at The Gregory Arms. Contact them directly for availability.

What time must we leave the next day?

• The Bridal Suite must be vacated by 11:30 AM.

Do we need a microphone for speeches?

• A microphone and PA system are provided free of charge in the Long Gallery.

Can we use an easel for our table plan?

• Yes, easels are available for table plans, welcome signs & order of the day.

What time does the party end?

- Bar closes at 11:00 PM, and guests should depart by 12 AM.
- An extended bar licence is available upon request.



#### Logistics

- When must we confirm final numbers?
- 6 weeks before.

Is there a cloakroom?

• No, but hanging rails are available for guests' coats.

Can our photographer visit before the wedding?

• Yes, by appointment with the Events Team.

Should we have a break between day and evening events?

• We recommend a smooth transition, but we can customize the schedule.

Is the Manor lit at night?

• Yes, the front of the Manor is floodlit from dusk.

Can we have fireworks?

 $\bullet$  Yes, at an additional £500 fee. Suppliers must provide documentation in advance.

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Are Chinese lanterns allowed?

• No, due to environmental and safety concerns.

Are local hotels/B&Bs available?

- Yes, the Events Team can provide a list upon booking.
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Can we get ready at the Manor?

• Yes, if your ceremony is at Harlaxton. Maximum 8 guests in the Bridal & Dressing Suites.



### Decorations and accessories

We welcome your ideas and input into decorations at the Manor, though please bear in mind the following:

Can we use candles?

• Yes, in the Long Gallery if in safe holders (max 5 per table). Other areas require approval.

Can ceremony chairs be used for the reception?

• Yes, chairs can be moved from the Ceremony Room to the Long Gallery.

Can we use confetti?

• Only biodegradable confetti is permitted outdoors.

Can we use rose petals?

• Only fake rose petals on bedding, linens, and floors to prevent staining.

Are helium balloons allowed?

• No, due to high ceilings making retrieval difficult. Exceptions for the Long Gallery can be considered.



### Food and Drinks

What is the maximum number of guests allowed for the Wedding Breakfast?

• We can accommodate up to 140 guests in the Long Gallery for a formal seated dinner. Feel free to ask our team about alternative options.

What is the minimum number of guests for catering?

- Wedding Breakfast: Minimum 80 guests. For 50-80 guests, there is a £20 per person surcharge.
- Evening Food: Minimum 80 portions served by 9:30 PM (later times may incur additional charges).

Can we have outside catering?

• No, only Harlaxton Manor catering is permitted, except for a wedding cake.

Can we offer more than one menu option?

• Yes, but additional charges apply for multiple choices. Contact the Events Team for details.

Are menu prices subject to change?

• Yes, prices may increase due to inflation and supplier costs, particularly for weddings booked over 12 months in advance.

Can we have a Wedding Taster?

• Yes, weekday evenings in November for  $\pounds 180$  per couple (wine purchased separately).



# Booking with us

Can we visit before booking?

• Yes, book a show-around with a Wedding Coordinator.

How long can we provisionally hold a date?

• We do not provisionally hold dates. Bookings are first come, first served with a £2,000 deposit.

What is the payment schedule?

- 12 months prior: £3,000 payment due.
- 90 days prior: Remaining venue hire fee.
- 20 days prior: Catering invoice (based on final guest numbers, menu, and drinks).

# Traveling by car

The Manor is situated off the A607, approximately 3 miles west of Grantham. The entrance drive is immediately opposite The Gregory Arms Public House. If the gates are closed please follow the directions detailed below.

From the North or SouthA1—Turn off onto the A607

From the WestA52—Join the A1 southbound near Barrowby village, then turn off onto A607

From the EastA52—into Grantham; then that the A607 towards Melton Mowbray

### If the Main Gates are closed

Turn left into Harlaxton Village at the crossroads. Turn left again at the obelisk; continue and take the next left into Manor Drive. After a very short distance turn right (small housing development on the left), past the village cricket/bowls club on your right, and onto the Manor's Drive. Please be aware of speed bumps on the drive.

# Traveling by rail

The East Coast line from London Kings Cross to Edinburgh stops at Grantham. There is a regular and frequent service from London Kings Cross to Grantham, a journey which takes a little over 1 hour). There are also good rail connections east and west. You will need to hire a taxi to bring you from the railway station to Harlaxton Manor (about 3 miles).

### Main Entrance - Guests

For car parking please follow signs for the Visitors car park and for coaches, please park outside the Manor's front door in the front circle. Head towards double wooden front doors, doors will be open take a seat in waiting area. A member of staff will greet you.

# Reception Entrance - Suppliers

For car parking please follow signs for the Pegasus carpark. Head towards reception door (you will see a ramp) please buzz in and a member of staff will greet you.
